

I George Brazzel do make and publish
 this as my last will and Testament hereby
 revoking and making void all other wills
 by me at any time made. first I direct
 that my funeral expenses and all my debts be
 paid as soon after my death as possible out
 of any money that I may die possessed of
 or may come in to the hands of my Executor
 secondly; I give and bequeath to my wife
 Mary Brazzel all my House hold and kitchen
 furniture and also all my ^{stock} my Mare Hogs
 and Cattle and all the poultry and further I give
 my wife one hundred dollars in gold and
 silver and also one note on H. J. Mearns for Eighty
 five dollars notes on John Brazzel for forty seven dollars
 and one on Wilson Brazzel for four dollars
 and fifty Cents. I give all the above named
 property and money to my wife after my debts
^{are paid} and funeral expenses be paid out of the same
 and at the death of my wife what she has in her
 hands in money or property to be equally divided
 between all my children Thirdly I give and
 bequeath ^{my daughter} unto Priscilla Brazzel one hundred
 dollars fourthly I give and bequeath to my
 daughter Rebecca one hundred dollars to be
 paid to them out of the first money that my Executor
 collects after complying with ~~the~~ what I will to
 my wife and also I give Rebecca a Cow fifthly
 I give to the rest of my children one hundred
 dollars when collected of John Murrel and
 lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint Wilson
 Brazzel my Executor in witness whereof I do this my
 Will set my hand and seal this January the 17th A.D. 1859

 presence and we have subscribed our names } George his Brazzel
