WHEREAS *Solomon Hartley, of Cedar County, Missouri,*

ha I deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Springfield,* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Solomon Hartley according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the South East quarter, of the North East quarter, of Section ten, in Township thirty three, of Range twenty five, in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Springfield, Missouri, containing forty acres,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract *ha* I been purchased by the said *Solomon Hartley,*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *Solomon Hartley,*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

Solomon Hartley and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
