



Mrs. May Clark Of Amy Succumbs After Brief Illness

Mrs. May Clark, age 33 years, died at her home near Amy, in the southern part of Howell county, Thursday morning at 6 o'clock following a few days illness from influenza and complications. Her sister, Mrs Charles Lape of West Plains, who conducts the Oriental Hotel on South street, was called to her bedside the day before her death.
