

Helton A. Walker Dies Monday Night

Helton A. Walker, 85, died at his home on Darwin street at 10:30 p. m., Monday, November 25, 1957. He had only been ill a few days.

Mr. Walker was born August 10, 1872 at Trask, Mo. He had lived in this area 34 years and had been a resident of Liberal for 15 years. Mr. Walker and his wife Cora would have celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary January 18, 1958.
