FINAL JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE

The motion of the plaintiff for final judgment came on for hearing on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1944, upon all the files, papers, proceedings and records in the above entitled action, from which it appears, and the Court finds, that an interlocutory judgment of divorce was, on the 16th day of December 1918, entered in said cause in Judgment Book 5, at page 411; that no motion for a new trial has been made and no appeal has been taken;

Wherefore it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a divorce be, and it hereby is, granted and that the marriage between the above named plaintiff and defendant be, and the same is, hereby dissolved, and the said parties are restored to the status of single persons.

And it is further ordered that this decree be entered nunc pro tunc as of December 17, 1919.
