

Report of Findings

William L. Warren and James N. Warren were both convicted of Robbery in the 1st degree in Yuba County and sentenced to 5 years to life. They entered San Quentin State Prison on 19 January 1933.

William Warren served only 3 years. He was paroled on 3 February 1936 and was discharged from parole on 2 February 1938. James Warren did not appear in the Parolee Ledgers dated 1893-1940. He must have served a longer sentence than William. The California State Archives do not have parolee records for San Quentin after 1940. I transcribed the date of parole for William Warren from a ledger book. I was not allowed to make a copy due to the fragile condition of the ledger.

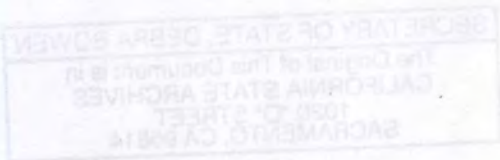
